
Tips for Multiple Choice & Other Selected-Response Assessments





- Identify course objectives for which selected-response assessment is appropriate and those for which another means of assessment is warranted
 - \circ $\;$ Write questions to measure course objectives, not trivia
 - $\circ \quad \text{Avoid trick items} \quad$
- Create a plan or blueprint...
 - \circ for distributing questions across content areas and cognitive skills being assessed
 - o for preparing questions of various levels of thinking
- State the question's central idea in the stem
 - Test one thing per question
 - Use positive stems
 - Say it as simply as possible
 - Place most of the content in the stem (not the alternatives)
- Use appropriate level of vocabulary (jargon)
- Use three (maybe four) answer options the correct answer and 2 or 3 distractors
- Make all answer options consistent
 - o Length
 - \circ Grammatical form
 - Homogeneous
- Place alternatives in logical order
- Make sure one alternative is clearly the best answer
 - Never use "All of the above"
 - Rarely, if ever, use "None of the above"
 - "Always" and "never" indicate that the answer is likely incorrect
 - o "Maybe", "usually", "typically" or "sometimes" indicate that the answer is likely correct
 - Eliminate overlapping alternatives
- Incorporate common student misunderstandings or errors in the distractors

Some questions can be answered correctly *for the wrong reason* – for example, something that points to the correct answer. Other questions have problems that introduce ambiguity.

All poorly constructed questions have the disadvantage that they do not measure whether a learner truly knows the correct answer.
